Cancer Grants

The Ladies Auxiliary has been a Partner in Cancer Aid and Research since our first gift of \$60,000 to a Laboratory in Maine more than 65 years ago. We will continue to contribute to the victory over cancer for our fellow sisters by providing Cancer Grants to members. And we will continue to fund cancer research striving to find a cure.

Raising Funds: Ladies Auxiliaries are encouraged to give \$2.00 per member of which 15% will be returned to Arkansas so that we may donate to a Research Facility in our own state and aid them in their search for finding a cure for cancer. We must attain the \$2.00 per member in order to receive the 15% from the National Organization.

NOTE: While there is no doubt that all effort to further the cure of finding a cure for cancer are worthy we ask that you focus your projects, publicity, and fundraising on the Ladies Auxiliary’s cancer-related programs. Any other projects or volunteer hours donated for other cancer-related organizations will not qualify for Auxiliary recognition or awards.

Post-Doctoral Fellowships are available to researchers and each year the National Organization awards two \$100,000 Fellowships. These Fellowships can’t be awarded in Arkansas if you don’t spread the word and promote the award in the local Universities, hospital and research centers. Education about the warning signs and the importance of early detection is also important. Selection: Outstanding Performance Award

The Department Chairman will select the recipients. **You must have reported a minimum of twice during the year.**

Criteria for selection:

40 Points Maximum ~ Development of overall program (creativity, presentation following Chairman’s emphasis.

30 Points Maximum ~ Quality of promotional material (newsletters, publicity, leaflets)

30 Points Maximum ~ Preparation by Chairman (legibly and clearly documented on report form)

1. Outstanding Performance Award, “It’s Time to Honor Our Veterans” award for the Auxiliary, in each Membership Group for the most effective promotion of CAR based on quality of material and timeliness of report, promotion of Cancer Grant program, the Post-Doctoral Fellowship, as well as achieving \$2 per member donation. Citation to runner-up
2. Citation in each Membership Group for best promotion of the Cancer Grant program
3. Citation in each Membership Group for best promotion of Cancer Research Program
4. Citation to each Auxiliary contributing more than \$2.00 or more per member to CAR fund.
5. Citation to the Department Chairman achieving 100% participation.
